



## SUPPLY LIST 2015-2016

### **Pre-K:**

- 2 packages of construction paper
- 1 smock or old t-shirt
- 24 ct. crayons
- markers
- 20 ct. pencils
- pencil box
- scissors (blunt point)
- 2 glue sticks
- 3 bottles of liquid glue
- 1 box Kleenex
- 1 pkg baby wipes
- 1 box small ziploc bags
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 folder with pockets for carrying papers to and from school

### **Kindergarten:**

- 24 pencils (Ticonderoga is best and at Walmart)  
*Please have some pencils sharpened, if possible*
- 2 24 ct. box crayons (not a box of 48)
- 1 12 ct. markers (Crayola, if possible)
- 1 box colored pencils (12 ct. at least)
- 1 pair safety scissors
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 box Kleenex
- 1 pkg baby wipes
- 2 basic sketch pads (found at Dollar Tree)
- 12" ruler with cm/in
- 1 binder pouch (to keep in the binder and hold flash cards)
- 2 plain 1" binders (cheap kind)
- 2 folders with 3-hole punch design (to go in the binder)

### **1st Grade:**

- 1 pkg Crayola markers (regular size and colors)
- Pencils (mechanical or 6 sided--pre sharpening is very helpful!)
- 1 pkg erasers (the big, pink kind)
- Scissors
- Plastic box to house above supplies in desk
- 8 count box of colored pencils
- 1 pkg of loose leaf paper (wide-rule)
- 1 homework folder with pockets (any color/preferably the plastic kind)
- 1 plain 1" binder
- 2 glue sticks
- Pencil sharpener that catches shavings
- 3x5 blank index cards (500 count)
- 1 plastic index card file box (should hold 300 cards)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 box of baby wipes

### **2nd Grade:**

- 3 packages of pencils (Ticonderoga is the best, mechanical pencils are fine but they need to know how to use them.)
- Package of colored pencils at least a 12 count, Crayola is best (please no crayons or markers)
- Pencil sharpener (that catches shavings)
- Pencil case/holder (the rectangular plastic kind is best)
- 12" ruler with English and Metric systems with clearly marked start point (the metal are best)
- 2 large erasers
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Notebook for homework
- Portfolios (folders) for Math (red), Grammar (yellow), Spelling (green), Memory (blue) with prongs in middle and inside flaps and one that is 'individual' (i.e. Superman) for homework (5 total)
- 2 boxes Kleenex
- Small size GermX (any brand, no scent)

- 2 individual 1-gallon Ziploc bags
- 1 pkg of loose-leaf paper (wide-rule)
- 500 count 3x5 cards
- Index card box to hold cards (plastic with snap lid)
- Backpack

### **3rd Grade:**

- 2 packages of Ticonderoga no.2 pencils (can have a few mechanical pencils too, if desired)
- 24 pack colored pencils sharpened
- Small pencil case for colored pencils
- 8-12 pack markers
- Pencil case for other supplies
- Pencil sharpener that catches shavings
- Yellow or light colored highlighter
- Ruler with English and Metric system
- Blue and red ballpoint pens
- Eraser
- 2 pkg of loose-leaf paper (wide-rule) unopened
- Scissors
- 1/4" graph paper for Math
- 1 single subject (wide-rule) notebook
- 1 package glue sticks (unopened)

### ***3rd grade Latin:***

- 4 dry erase markers
- 1 small index card holder (hold 100 cards)
- 1 folder for homework

### **4th Grade:**

- Package of pencils, mechanical is fine
- Package of colored pencils
- Pencil sharpener that catches shavings
- Yellow or light colored highlighter
- Ruler with English and Metric system
- Blue and red ballpoint pens
- Pencil case/holder

- Eraser
- Package of looseleaf paper (wide-rule)
- Scissors
- 1" binder
- 1/4" graph paper for Math
- 1 composition book
- 3 folders (2 pockets)(3 prong)
- Dry erase markers (individual dry erase boards & erasers are provided)
- Assignment book

#### ***4th Grade Latin:***

- 4 dry erase markers
- 1 small index card holder (hold 100 cards)
- 4 different colored highlighters
- 1 folder for homework

#### **5th-6th Grade:**

- 1 package of colored pencils (no crayons or markers)
- 1 package of #2 pencils or mechanical pencils
- 1 glue stick
- 1 light colored highlighter
- 1 ruler with English and Metric system
- 1 black or blue ballpoint pen
- 2 pencil cases/holders
- 1 eraser (Pink Pearl type)
- 3 packages of loose-leaf paper (college-rule)
- 1 pack of black dry erase markers (individual dry erase boards & erasers are provided)
- 2 packs graph paper
- 1 compass
- 1 protractor
- 1 pair of scissors

**5th-6th Grade Latin:**
