Pre-K:

- 24 ct. crayons
- washable markers
- 8 black dry erase markers
- 12 ct. box of pencils
- pencil box
- scissors (blunt point)
- bottle of liquid glue (not Elmer's)
- roll paper towels
- 1 folder with pockets
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 pkg of baby wipes

Kindergarten:

- 24 ct. box crayons
- 10 ct. fat markers (Crayola)
- 12 ct. colored pencils
- 4 fine tip black dry erase markers
- pkg large pink erasers
- pair safety scissors
- 3 glue sticks
- box Kleenex
- baby wipes
- 8x10 spiral bound sketch pad, preferably 70 sheets or more (Walmart & Ollie's both carry these for under \$5)
- binder pouch (to keep in the binder and hold flash cards)
- 2 plain 1" binders (cheap kind)
- folder with 3-hole punch design (to go in the binder)

1st Grade:

- pkg Crayola markers (thick size is preferred)
- pencils (mechanical or 6 sided--pre sharpening is very helpful!)
- pkg erasers (the big, pink kind)
- 2 black dry erase markers
- scissors
- 12 count box of colored pencils
- homework folder to put in binder (any color)
- 2 folders with prongs (1 red, 1 blue)
- plain 1" binder
- binder pouch
- 3 glue sticks
- pencil sharpener that catches shavings
- box of Kleenex
- baby wipes
- 1 composition book (wide rule)
- 1 pack of loose-leaf paper (wide rule)

2nd Grade:

- mechanical pencils (24 ct)
- Ticonderoga pencils (24 ct)
- 24 ct Crayola colored pencils
- 1 pkg Crayola markers
- pencil sharpener (that catches shavings & fits in pencil box)
- pencil case/holder (the rectangular plastic kind)
- 2 large erasers (white)
- 1 pkg of Papermate "hat" erasers
- 1 glue stick
- notebook for homework
- 3 folders with prongs & pockets: 1 red, 1 blue, 1 green
- 1 "individual" pocket folder without prongs (i.e. Superman)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 3 individual 1-gallon Ziploc bags
- 2 packs of loose-leaf paper (wide rule)
- 1 zippered pocket that is at least 6x9
- hand sanitizer (non-scented, 8 oz)
- Clorox wipes (if not available, then baby wipes)

3rd Grade:

- 24 ct Ticonderoga pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 24 ct Crayola colored pencils (non-erasable)
- 1 large pink eraser
- 4 packs of eraser caps (or 2 large packs)
- 1 pencil box, hinged-lid
- 2 packs of loose-leaf paper (wide-rule)
- 1 glue stick
- 1 wide-ruled composition book for journaling
- 2 **plastic** colored folders with pockets & brads
- 2 black dry erase markers
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 4 sheet protectors
- 1 12 inch wooden ruler
- 1 scissors (sharp)

4th Grade:

- 3 wide-ruled composition books – preferably hard cover (cardboard) and can be decorative
- Plastic** pocket folder with prongs (any color or design)
- 48 wood pencils – no mechanical or plastic/decorative pencils and no pens
- 2 red pencils
- 4 big pink erasers (other colors are fine)
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 2 highlighters (any color)
- pencil case for classroom
- 1 ½" binder
- binder divider tabs with pockets (enough for five sections)
